# BY-LAW

Number 225-2005

To amend the Zoning By-law 2004 (By-law 270-2004) as amended


The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. The Zoning By-law 2004, as amended, is hereby further amended:
  - (1) by adding the following to Section 1026:
 

"1026.3 shall also be subject to the requirements and restrictions relating to the M4A-Section 186 Zone, and all the general provisions of this by-law which are not in conflict with the ones set out in Section 1026.2."
  - (2) by deleting the words "within the first 30 metres of the building depth;" from Section 1512.2(8) and adding the words "within the first 30 metres of the building depth" to the end of the sentence in Section 1512.2(7)(c):
  - (3) by changing the references of "Section 3223" and "Section 3304" from Schedule C attached thereto to references of "Section 3304" and "Section 3223" respectively.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME, and PASSED, in open COUNCIL, this  
11<sup>th</sup> day of July 2005.

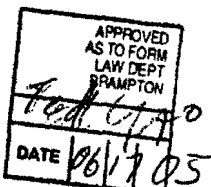

DECLARATION


I, Leonard Joseph Mikulich, of the Town of Shelburne, in the County of Dufferin, do solemnly declare that:
