## **BY-LAW**

Number	228-88		

To amend By-law 200-82, as amended, in respect of parking of large motor vehicles

The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. By-law 200-82, as amended, is hereby further amended:
  - a) by deleting from Section 5.0 (DEFINITIONS), the definition of LARGE MOTOR VEHICLE; and
  - b) by adding to Section 5.0 the following definition of LARGE MOTOR VEHICLE:

"LARGE MOTOR VEHICLE shall mean any motor vehicle having a vehicle weight greater than 2500 kilograms and an overall height greater than 2.3 metres".

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 12th day of October , 1988.
