To authorize the transfer of easement over
Part of Block 241, Plan 43M-1400
designated as Parts 1, 2 and 3 on draft
reference plan, prepared by Rady-Pentek
Surveying Ltd., Job No. 03-143

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient in the interest of The Corporation of the City of Brampton that a transfer of easement over Part of Block 241, Plan 43M-1400 designated as Parts 1, 2 and 3 on draft reference plan, Job No. 03-143 prepared by Rady-Pentek & Edward Surveying Ltd. (the "Lands") be conveyed to The Regional Municipality of Peel (the "Region");

AND WHEREAS the Lands were conveyed to the City for nominal consideration by the owner of the abutting lands and the Region requires an easement over the Lands for watermain and storm sewer purposes;

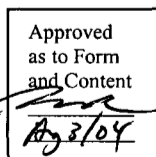
AND WHEREAS the procedures required by section 268 of the *Municipal Act, 2001* have been carried out;


AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton has heard in person or by counsel, solicitor or agent, all persons claiming that their land will be prejudicially affected by this by-law and who applied to be heard;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**


1. The transfer of easement for nominal consideration over the Lands in favour of the Region is hereby authorized and the City Solicitor is hereby authorized to execute all documents and instruments as may be necessary to effect the conveyance of the said lands.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 11th day of August, 2004.
