# BY-LAW

Number 230-76

A By-law to accept and assume lands as part of a public highway in the City of Brampton.


WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to accept and assume lands in conveyance and dedicate same as parts of public highway;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. The land described in deeds of conveyance to the Corporation of the City of Brampton listed on Schedule "A" hereto attached, be and the same are hereby accepted and the said lands are assumed as part of the public highway adjacent thereto, as indicated on Schedule "A".
