**AMENDMENT NUMBER OP93 - 24**  
**TO THE OFFICIAL PLAN OF THE**  
**CITY OF BRAMPTON PLANNING AREA**

**1.0 Purpose:**

The purpose of this amendment is to add to the list of amendments pertaining to Secondary Plan Area 6: Brampton West, to include Amendment Number 255 255A to the document known as the 1984 Official Plan.

**2.0 Location:**

The lands subject to this amendment are generally located at the south-west corner of the intersection Nelson Street West and Haggert Avenue North within Lot 6, Concession 1, West of Hurontario Street, in the City of Brampton.

**3.0 Amendment and Policies Relative Thereto:**

The document known as the Official Plan of the City of Brampton Planning Area is hereby amended:

- (1) by adding to the list of amendments pertaining to Secondary Plan Area 6: Brampton West as set out in Part II: Secondary Plans, Amendment Number 255 A to the document known as the 1984 Official Plan.
