- (1) That Schedule "A" to By-law Number 39-74 be amended by the addition thereto of the following under the appropriate columns thereof.


COLUMN 1
INTERSECTION


COLUMN 2
FACING TRAFFIC

Mill Street & Nelson Street	Northbound on Mill Street
Mill Street & Nelson Street	Southbound on Mill Street
Mill Street & Nelson Street	Eastbound on Nelson Street
Mill Street & Nelson Street	Westbound on Nelson Street

- (2) The provisions of this By-law shall not become effective until approved by the Council of the Corporation of the Regional Municipality of Peel.
