

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

BY-LAW NUMBER 237-75

To amend By-law Number 187-75 to prescribe speed limits on portions of certain highways.

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton deems it expedient and advisable to amend By-law Number 187-75, being a by-law to prescribe speed limits on portions of certain highways.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. That Schedule "B" to By-law Number 187-75 be amended by the deletion therefrom of the following under the appropriate columns thereof:

MAXIMUM RATE OF SPEED 40 M.P.H.

<u>HIGHWAY</u>	<u>FROM</u>	<u>TO</u>
First Line East	Steeles Avenue	A point 4,200 feet south of Steeles Ave.

2. That Schedule "B" to By-law Number 187-75 be amended by the addition thereto of the following under the appropriate columns thereof:

<u>HIGHWAY</u>	<u>FROM</u>	<u>TO</u>
First Line East	A point 1,700 feet south of Steeles Ave.	A point 4,200 feet south of Steeles Ave.

3. The provisions of this by-law shall not become effective until approved by the Council of the Corporation of the Regional Municipality of Peel.


