To amend By-law 193-83 (the regulation of traffic) for the placement of an ALL WAY STOP, SCHOOL BUS LOADING ZONE and PARKING REGULATIONS

The council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton hereby ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law 193-83, as amended, is hereby further amended:

(1) by adding to the specified columns of Schedule VIII thereto the following items:

THROUGH HIGHWAYS

COLUMN 1 <u>HIGHWAY</u>

COLUMN 2 BETWEEN

Major William Sharpe Drive

The north limit of the road and the north limit of Burgby Avenue/Gowland Gate

Major William Sharpe Drive

The south limit of Burgby Avenue/Gowland Gate and the north limit of the Queen Street West

(2) by adding to the specified columns of Schedule IX thereto the following items:

STOP SIGNS

COLUMN 1 INTERSECTION

Major William Sharpe Drive & Burgby Avenue/Gowland Gate

COLUMN 2 FACING TRAFFIC

Northbound on Major William Sharpe Drive

Southbound on Major William Sharpe Drive

Eastbound on Gowland Gate

Westbound on Burgby Avenue

(3) by adding to the specified columns of Schedule I thereto the following items:

NO PARKING ON SPECIFIED HIGHWAYS
