	To amend By-law 151-88, as amended.
The Coun	cil of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as
follows:	

- 1. By-law 151-88, as amended, is hereby further amended:
 - (1). by changing on Sheet 21A of Schedule A thereto, the zoning designation of the lands shown outlined on Schedule A to this by-law from AGRICULTURAL (A) to OPEN SPACE -SECTION 1073 (OS-Section 1073)
 - (2). By adding thereto, the following section:
 - "1073.1 The lands designated OS Section 1073 on sheet 21A of Schedule A to this by-law:
 - shall only be used for the following purposes:
 - (1) sports fields;
 - (2) parking lot;
 - (3) temporary storage facility for equipment associated with the permitted use.
 - shall also be subject to the requirements and restrictions relating to the OS zone and all the general provisions of this by-law.




