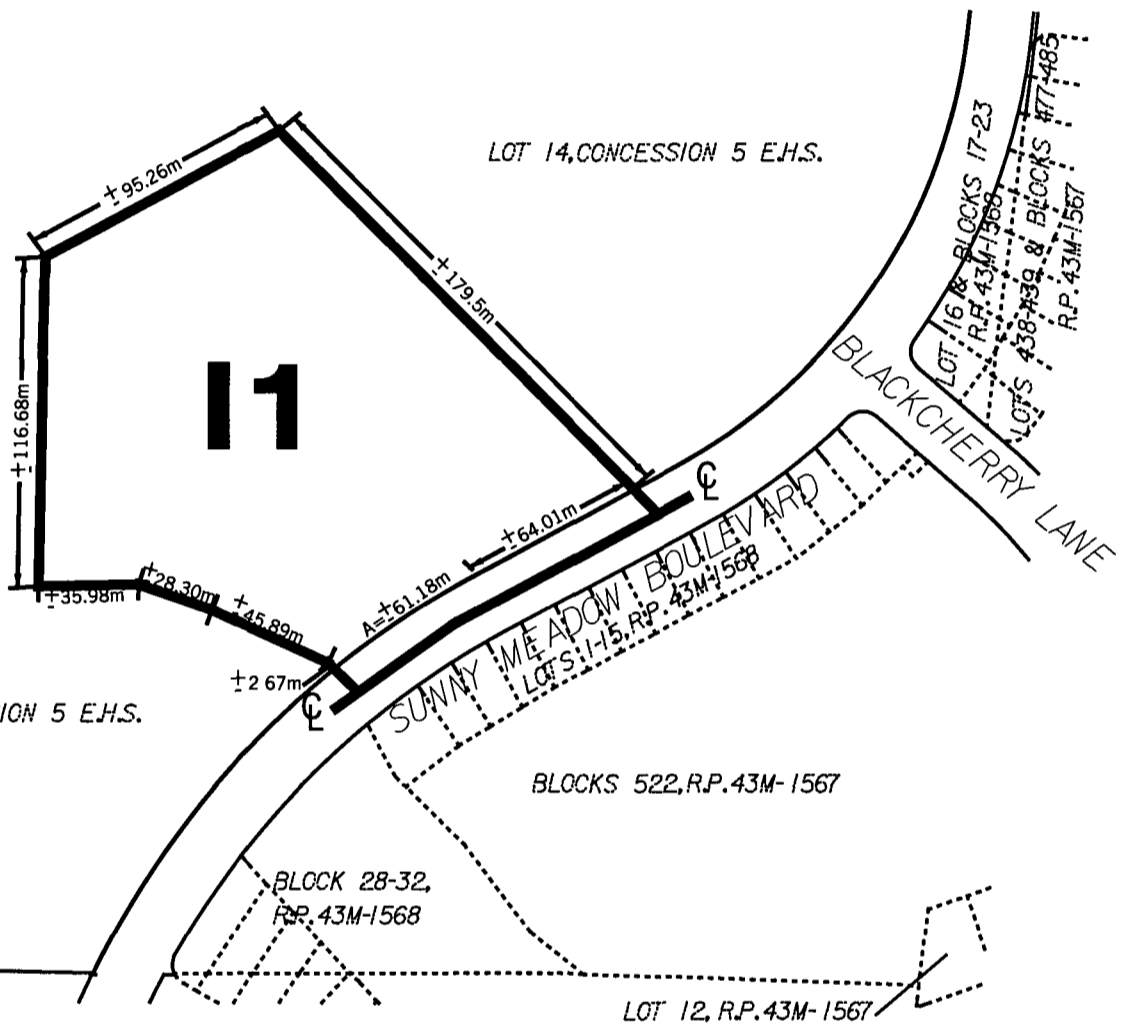


DECLARATION
