By-law	to	prohibit	throwing,	placing

A By-law to prohibit throwing, placing or depositing snow, ice or slush on public highways.

THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:-

- No person shall throw, place or deposit snow, ice or slush on to the travelled portion of any public highway or lane.
- No person shall deposit or cause to be deposited, snow, ice or slush on boulevards in a manner that creates a visual barrier to vehicular traffic.
- 3. Where any person or persons contravenes this By-law, the City may forthwith cause the removal of the snow, ice or slush which creates a visual barrier and the cost thereof shall be added to the owner's tax bill and collected in the same manner as municipal taxes.
- Any person convicted of a breach of any of the provisions of this By-law shall forfeit and pay at the discretion of the convicting Provincial Judge or Justice of the Peace, a penalty not exceeding the sum of \$1,000.00 exclusive of costs, for each offence.
