
A By-law to prohibit throwing, placing or depositing snow, ice or slush on public highways.

THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:-

1. No person shall throw, place or deposit snow, ice or slush on to the travelled portion of any public highway or lane.
2. No person shall deposit or cause to be deposited, snow, ice or slush on boulevards in a manner that creates a visual barrier to vehicular traffic.
3. Where any person or persons contravenes this By-law, the City may forthwith cause the removal of the snow, ice or slush which creates a visual barrier and the cost thereof shall be added to the owner's tax bill and collected in the same manner as municipal taxes.
4. Any person convicted of a breach of any of the provisions of this By-law shall forfeit and pay at the discretion of the convicting Provincial Judge or Justice of the Peace, a penalty not exceeding the sum of \$1,000.00 exclusive of costs, for each offence.
