Number 244-2002

To authorize the purchase of certain
lands for a fire station site

Section 191 of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.M.45 authorizes the council of every municipal corporation to pass by-laws for acquiring any land required for the purposes of the Corporation.


The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton has determined that it is necessary to acquire land in the Intermodal Drive/Airport Road area for the purpose of constructing a fire station.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**


1. The purchase of a 1.6 acre parcel of land on the south side of Intermodal Drive immediately west of Midair Court, for the purpose of constructing a fire station, is hereby authorized.
2. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute an agreement of purchase and sale, in a form approved by the City Solicitor, between Canadian Tire Corporation Limited and The Corporation of the City of Brampton, together with all other documents that in the opinion of the City Solicitor are necessary to effect the purchase of the land.
