



THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

BY-LAW

Number 246-83

To stop up and close and sell
a certain part of Orenda Road

WHEREAS, by an agreement between the former Town of Brampton and Maple Leaf Mills Limited, dated 3 December 1971, the former Town of Brampton agreed to stop up and close and convey to Maple Leaf Mills Limited the part of Orenda Road designated as Part 4 on reference plan RD-305;

AND WHEREAS The Corporation of the City of Brampton is the successor in title to the former Town of Brampton, and thus has jurisdiction over this part of Orenda Road;

AND WHEREAS notice of the intention to pass this by-law has been published once a week for four consecutive weeks in the Daily Times, a newspaper published in the City of Brampton;

AND WHEREAS the City has given notice to The Regional Municipality of Peel, pursuant to section 49 of the Regional Municipality of Peel Act (R.S.O. 1980, c. 440, as amended) and The Regional Municipality of Peel has indicated that it does not object to such stopping up;

AND WHEREAS the Council for the said Corporation has heard in person or by his counsel, solicitor or agent, all persons claiming that their land will be prejudicially affected by this by-law and who applied to be heard;


NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The part of Orenda Road more particularly described in Schedule A to this by-law is hereby stopped up and closed.
2. The sale of the lands stopped up and closed by this by-law, to the owner of the abutting lands, for the sum of two dollars, is hereby authorized.
3. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute all documents and instruments that may be necessary to give effect to this by-law.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council, this 12th day of September, 1983.


