Number 247-77


A By-law to amend By-law Number 2296 of the former Corporation of the Town of Brampton, to establish prices and rates charged for grave plots and cemetery services in the City of Brampton Cemetery.

1. That, effective October 1st, 1977, the rates as set out in Schedule "A" hereto be the rates charged for grave plots and cemetery services in the City of Brampton Cemetery.

The above prices include Perpetual Care.

From the above purchase prices, the Corporation of the City of Brampton shall make the following allocations to the Perpetual Care Fund:

One Adult Grave Plot	\$ 70.00

Four Adult Grave Plots	250.00
One Child's Grave Plot	30.00
Infant Grave Plot	10.00
Cremation Plots (2 Urn Spaces)	10.00

For funerals entering cemetery -

On Saturdays - before 12:00 noon	30.00
On Saturdays - after 12:00 noon	50.00
On Statutory Holidays	75.00

DISINTERMENT CHARGES

LOWERING REMAINS TO PLACE SECOND BODY ON TOP  
(IF NOT ALREADY EXTRA DEEP)

REMOVAL OF REMAINS AND REBURIALS IN ANOTHER LOCATION IN  
THE SAME CEMETERY - (FROM STANDARD DEPTH TO STANDARD DEPTH)

REMOVAL OF REMAINS ONLY, FOR REBURIAL IN ANOTHER CEMETERY

Adult	\$ 130.00

Winter Interment charges (Dec. 16-Apr.14) will be extra to above.

OUTER CONTAINER

Casket or outer container other than steel or concrete - extra charge \$ 50.00

Extra service charge on outer container over 34 inches wide or more than 28 inches in depth; such service charge to be allocated to the Perpetual Care Fund \$ 20.00

MONUMENT FOUNDATIONS

Concrete for monument foundations will be built by the Corporation at the expense of the plot owners, and will be charged for at the following rates:

Base 10 sq.ft. or less - minimum depth 5' \$ 75.00  
Extra deep - minimum 7' 100.00

Increase in above size will be charged at the rate of \$7.50 per sq.ft. for each sq.ft. or part thereof over 10 sq.ft.

Minimum depth of a foundation next to a double depth grave shall be 7'. Foundations on two grave plots are restricted to a maximum length of 4'6" and a maximum height of 1'.

Application for foundation must be made to the manager of the cemetery. A plan sketch of the monument to be erected with all dimensions shown, and the material and finish of each part shown, must be submitted to and receive approval of the manager before orders for foundations will be executed.
