BY-LAW

Number 247-83

To establish a community recreation centre known as Bruce Beer Park

WHEREAS section 2(1) of the Community Recreation Centres Act provides that the council of a municipality may, by by-law, provide for the establishment, maintenance and operation of a community recreation centre in accordance with the said Act:

AND WHEREAS The Corporation of the City of Brampton has purchased a part of Block M, Registered Plan M-27, from Victoria Wood Development Corporation Inc.;


AND WHEREAS The Corporation of the City of Brampton is desirous of establishing the said lands and buildings and facilities thereon as a community recreation centre;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. A community recreation centre, consisting of the land in Brampton described as the parts of Block M on Registered Plan M-27 designated as Parts 8 and 9 on reference plan 43R-10292, and all the buildings, structures and facilities thereon, including the soccer and softball fields, the skating rink, basketball court, jogging track, playground and other playing fields, is hereby established in accordance with the provisions of the Community Recreation Centres Act (R.S.O. 1980, c.80, as amended) to be operated and maintained by The Corporation of the City of Brampton.

2. This community recreation centre shall be known as "BRUCE BEER PARK".
3. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute all documents necessary to implement this by-law.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in open council this 12th day of September, 1983.
