

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

BY-LAW

A by-law to stop up and close and authorize the sale of a certain part of Cassander Crescent

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient in the interest of The Corporation of the City of Brampton that a part of Cassander Crescent be relocated;

AND WHEREAS to effect such a relocation it is necessary that a certain part of Cassander Crescent be stopped up and closed, and sold to the owners of abutting lands;

AND WHEREAS notice of the intention to pass this by-law has been published once a week for four consecutive weeks in the Daily Times, a newspaper published in the City of Brampton;

AND WHEREAS the said Corporation has given notice to The Regional Municipality of Peel, pursuant to section 51 of The Regional Municipality of Peel Act, 1973, and The Regional Municipality of Peel has indicated that it does not object to such stopping up;

AND WHEREAS the Council for the said Corporation has heard in person or by his counsel, solicitor or agent, all persons claiming that their land will be prejudicially affected by this by-law and who applied to be heard;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

 That part of Cassander Crescent more particularly described in Schedule A attached to this by-law be and the same is hereby stopped up and closed.

- 2. IT IS HEREBY AUTHORIZED that the said lands stopped up and closed by this by-law be sold to the owners of the abutting lands or any one of them for the sum of Two Dollars (\$2.00).
- 3. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute all documents and instruments as may be necessary to effect the conveyance of the lands stopped up and closed by this By-law, and to acquire any property necessary to effect the relocation of Gassander Crescent.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 22nd day of September, 1980.
