To centre known as Centennial Recreation Centre

WHEREAS section 2(1) of the Community Recreation Centres Act provides that the council of a municipality may, by by-law, provide for the establishment, maintenance and operation of a community recreation centre in accordance with the said Act;

AND WHEREAS The Corporation of the City of Brampton owns and operates the CENTENNIAL RECREATION CENTRE at 80 Mary Street in Brampton;

AND WHEREAS the said CENTENNIAL RECREATION CENTRE was not previously established in accordance with the said Act;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. A community recreation centre, consisting of the lands and premises described as parts of Lots 9, 10 and 13 on Plan BR-21 and municipally known as 80 Mary Street in Brampton, and the buildings and facilities thereon, including the community hall and the meeting and crafts rooms, is hereby established in accordance with the provision of the Community Recreation Centres Act (R.S.O. 1980, c.80, as amended), to be operated and maintained by The Corporation of the City of Brampton.

- 2. This community recreation centre shall be known as the "CENTENNIAL RECREATION CENTRE".
- 3. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute all documents necessary to implement this by-law.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in open council this 12th day of September , 1983.
