

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

BY-LAW

Number ______249-83 ____

To prevent the application of Part Lot Control of certain lands within Brampton (Darcel Construction Company)

WHEREAS subsection 49 (5) of the <u>Planning Act</u> (S.O. 1983, Chapter 1, as amended) has imposed part lot control on all lands within registered plans within the City;

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to subsection 49 (7) of the <u>Planning Act</u>, the council of the municipality may by by-law provide that part lot control does not apply to lands within such registered plans or parts thereof as are designated in the by-law;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

- Subsection 5 of section 49 of the Planning Act does not apply to the land that is described in Schedule A to this by-law.
- 2. This by-law shall come into force upon approval thereof by the Regional Municipality of Peel.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 12th day of September, 1983.
