To authorize a c	apital expenditure
in the amount of	\$3,756,000.00 for
the construction	of certain works

WHEREAS The Corporation of the City of Brampton desires to undertake the construction of certain works;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

- The Corporation of the City of Brampton shall undertake the construction of the projects set out in Schedule A to this by-law at a total estimated cost of \$3,756,000.00.
- 2. The Mayor and the Treasurer are hereby authorized to borrow from time to time, in the name of and on behalf of the City, from the Royal Bank of Canada at 1 Main Street North in Brampton, a sum or sums not exceeding in the aggregate \$3,756,000.00, for the projects set out in Schedule A to this by-law, and to give to the Royal Bank of Canada on behalf of the City, promissory notes signed by the Mayor and the Treasurer under the corporate seal for the money so borrowed, containing terms and conditions satisfactory to the Treasurer.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 12th day of September, 1983.

SCHEDULE A TO BY-LAW NO. 250-83

1. RURAL ROAD UPGRADING AT SELECTED LOCATIONS

TERM

Reconstruct existing rural gravel roads including excavation, ditching, drainage works, granular base, paving and related works.

20 years

2. RECONSTRUCTION OF DAVIDSON ROAD FROM RUTHERFORD ROAD TO 270M EASTERLY

The work consists of reconstructing and widening to four lanes of Davidson Road from Rutherford Road to 270 M east of Rutherford Road.

Included in the work is excavation, granular base, curb and gutter, paving, storm sewers, sidewalks, utility relocations plus related work.

20 years

3. STORM SEWER CONSTRUCTION ON VARIOUS STREETS

Construction of new storm sewers on various streets including excavation, installation of new storm sewers and storm drainage works, backfill and restoration plus related works.

20 years

4. WIDENING OF WEST DRIVE FROM ORENDA ROAD TO 330 METRES SOUTH OF HWY. #7

The widening to four lanes of West Drive from 330 metres south of Hwy. #7 to Orenda Road from a two lane gravel shoulder roadway to a four lane curb and guttered section. The work is to include excavation, granular base, curb and gutter, asphalt paving and HL3 asphalt overlay, storm sewers, sidewalks, street lighting, utility relocations, plus related works.

5. WATERCOURSE IMPROVEMENTS FROM RUTHERFORD ROAD AT WORKS YARD TO 400 METRES SOUTH-EASTERLY

The construction of a lined channel for the watercourse located on lots 4 and 5, Concession II E.H.S. from Rutherford Road south-easterly approximately 400 metres. The work includes excavation, channel liner material, sodding and restoration plus related works.

20 years

6. MISCELLANEOUS LAND ACQUISITION

TERM

The work will include acquisition of various properties in conjunction with road and sewer construction projects.

20 years

7. CLARK BOULEVARD WIDENING FROM HWY. 410 LIMITS EASTERLY TO WEST DRIVE INCLUDING INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS

The widening of Clark Boulevard from two lanes to four lanes including intersection improvements at West Drive, traffic signal relocations, excavation, granular base, curb and gutter asphalt paving and HL3 asphalt overlay, storm sewers, sidewalks, street lighting, utility relocations, plus related works.

20 years

8. CONSTRUCTION AND REPLACEMENT OF SIDEWALKS -- VARIOUS LOCATIONS

The construction and reconstruction of concrete sidewalks at various locations in the City of Brampton including excavation, removal of existing sidewalk (where applicable), formwork, placing and curing of concrete sidewalk and related works.

10 years

9. UPGRADING OF VARIOUS STREETS

The reconstruction of various streets in the City of Brampton to improve traffic capacity, drainage and rideability and reduce maintenance costs.

The work will include excavation, storm sewers, granular base, curbs and gutter, sidewalks, roadway pavement, street lighting, traffic signal and/or utility relocations plus related works.

20 years

10. THE WIDENING OF GLIDDEN ROAD FROM GLIDDEN ROAD TO STEELES AVENUE

The work will include widening the roadway to four lanes, storm sewers, curb and gutter, sidewalks, roadway pavement, utility and/or traffic signals relocations, street lighting, plus related works.

20 years

11. STREETLIGHTING

TERM

Installation of new street lights at the following

locations including all related works.

- (a) Rutherford Road Queen Street to Davidson Road
- (b) Scott Street & Woodward AvenueChurch Street to Centre Streetupgrading
- (c) Peel Village Pole Replacement
- (d) Intersection of Harold Street & McMurchy
 Avenue
- (e) Ardglen Area Upgrading
- (f) Various Rural Intersections



12. MISCELLANEOUS TRAFFIC SIGNALS

Installation of traffic signals at the following locations including all related works.

- (a) Rutherford Road & Archdekin Drive
- (b) McLaughlin Road & Elgin Drive
