 - (2) by renumbering the Section 10.6(3) as applied to "A boat or trailer" to Section 10.6(5)

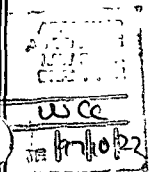



