WHEREAS subsection 50(5) of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. c. P.13, as amended, has imposed part lot control on all lands within registered plans within the City;

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to subsection 50(7) of the *Planning Act*, the Council of a municipality may, by by-law, provide that subsection 50(5) of the *Planning Act* does not apply to land within such registered plan or plans of subdivision or parts thereof, as are designated in the by-law;

AND WHEREAS, the application for an exemption from part lot control, pursuant to subsection 50(7) of the *Planning* Act, on the lands described below, for the purpose of creating maintenance easements on Lots 147 to 160, 163, 165, 166, 169, 171 to 173, 175, 176, 178 to 183, 185, 186, 188, 190, 191, 193, 194, 196, 197, 199, 200, 202 to 205, 207 to 216, 219, 220, 222, 223, 225, 226, 229 to 232, 235 to 241, 242 to 247, 249 to 254, 257 to 260, 262, 263, 266 to 270, 272, 274, 275, 277, 278, 280 to 289, 295, 296 and for the purpose of creating lots to facilitate semi-detached and townhouse units on Lots 298 to 304 and Blocks 305 to 308 and 311 and for the purpose of creating lots for townhouse units and private stormwater servicing easements on Blocks 309 and 310; is to the satisfaction of the City of Brampton; and

NOW THEREFORE, The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. THAT subsection 50(5) of the *Planning Act* does not apply to the following lands:
