To Stop-up and Close and Declare Surplus about 0.13 acre of land that is part of Lynch Street extending south of Queen Street East to just south of John Street


WHEREAS it is deemed expedient in the interest of The Corporation of the City of Brampton that about 0.13 acres of vacant land being that part of Lynch Street, extending south of John Street and described as Block B, Railway Block, Plan BR-5, as illustrated on attached Schedule A (the "Subject Property"), be declared surplus to the requirements of the City of Brampton;


AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton has heard in person or by counsel, solicitor or agent, all persons claiming that their land will be prejudicially affected by this by-law and who applied to be heard;

NOW THEREFORE The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**


1. THAT the 0.13 acre portion of Lynch Street, lying southeast of John Street, as illustrated on Schedule A, and described as Lynch Street Lying Southeast of John Street, being Block B, Railway Block, Plan BR-5 be stopped up and closed and declared surplus to the City's requirements.
