The council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law 200-82, as amended, is hereby further amended:

Number.

(1) by deleting from section 5.0 the definition of <u>BUILDING</u> and substituting therefore the following:

> "<u>BUILDING</u> shall mean any structure, whether temporary or permanent, used or erected for the shelter, accommodation or enclosure of persons, animals, materials or equipment, and shall not include a house trailer or mobile home."
