## THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

A by-law to amend By-law 160-92, as amended, To make housekeeping amendments to the by-law establishing Brampton Fire and Emergency Services

WHEREAS By-law 160-92 provides for the appointment of officials of the Corporation of the City of Brampton;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS** as follows:

Section 3 of By-law 160-92, as amended, be deleted and the 1. following substituted therefor:

- 3. Fire and Emergency Services shall consist of the Fire Chief, one or more Deputy Fire Chiefs, and such number of other officers, members and clerical staff as are authorized from time to time by the Council to perform the duties of Fire and Emergency Services.
- 2. Section 7 of By-law 160-92, as amended, be deleted and the following substituted therefor:

7. A Deputy Fire Chief shall be the second ranking officer of Fire and Emergency Services and it shall be such Deputy Fire Chief's responsibility to carry out the orders of the Fire Chief, and, in the absence of the Fire Chief, has all the powers and shall perform all duties of the Fire Chief.

That Sections 1 and 2 of this by-law shall come into force and effect 3. as of October 8, 2008.
