To prevent the application of part lot control to part of Registered Plan 43M-1405, and 43M-1409

WHEREAS subsection 50(5) of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990 c.P.13, has imposed part lot control on all lands within registered plans within the City;

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to subsection 50(7) of the Planning Act, the Council of a municipality may by by-law provide that part lot control does not apply to lands within such registered plans or parts thereof as are designated in the by-law;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton hereby ENACTS as follows:

Subsection 5 of section 50 of the <u>Planning Act</u>, does not apply to the following lands: 1.

City of Brampton, Regional Municipality of Peel, being composed of:

- the whole of Blocks 132, 142 and 143, on Registered Plan 43M-1405
- the whole of Lots 1-5 inclusive, 16-20 inclusive, 22-28 inclusive, 30, 34, 35, 51-65 inclusive, 87, 88, 131 – 158 inclusive, on Registered Plan 43M-1409
- the whole of Blocks 159 170 inclusive, 179 and 180, on Registered Plan 43M-1409
