Number 255-84

To stop up and close Calvertdale
Road on Registered Plan M-192

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient in the interest of The Corporation of the City of Brampton that Calvertdale Road be stopped up and closed;

AND WHEREAS notice of the intention to pass this by-law has been published once a week for four consecutive weeks in the Daily Times, a newspaper published in the City of Brampton;


AND WHEREAS the said Corporation has given notice to The Regional Municipality of Peel pursuant to Section 49 of the Regional Municipality of Peel Act (R.S.O. 1980, c. 440, as amended) and The Regional Municipality of Peel has indicated that it does not object to such stopping up;


AND WHEREAS the Council for the said Corporation has heard in person or by his counsel, solicitor or agent, all persons claiming that their land will be prejudicially affected by this by-law and who applied to be heard;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Calvertdale Road as shown on a plan of subdivision registered in the Land Registry Office for the Land Titles Division of Peel (No. 43) as number M-192 is hereby stopped up and closed.
