

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

BY-LAW

Number	255-94	

To authorize the reconstruction and alteration of Union Street on Plan BR-2 from Nelson Street East to a point south of the Canadian National Railways right-of-way

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient in the interest of The Corporation of the City of Brampton that the part of Union Street from Nelson Street East to a point south of the Canadian National Railways right-of-way be reconstructed and altered;

AND WHEREAS notice of the intention to pass this by-law has been published once a week for four consecutive weeks in the Brampton Guardian, a newspaper published in the City of Brampton;

AND WHEREAS the Council for the said Corporation has heard in person or by counsel, solicitor or agent, all persons claiming that their land will be prejudicially affected by this by-law and who applied to be heard;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The reconstruction and alteration of Union Street on Plan BR-2 from Nelson Street East to a point south of the Canadian National Railways right-of-way is hereby authorized.
- 2. The work shall be performed as part of the Queen's Square Infrastructure Project.
- The affidavit of Leonard J. Mikulich attached as Schedule A to this by-law forms part of this by-law.

READ a FIRST, SECOND, and THIRD TIME, and PASSED in open Council this 12th day of December, 1994.
