# BY-LAW

Number 256-81

To amend By-law 861, as amended, by By-law 877, and as further amended, of the former Township of Chinguacousy, now in the City of Brampton.

The Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law 861, as amended, is amended:

(1) by adding to section 2 (DEFINITIONS) the following, as subsection 32a:

"32a KENNEL shall mean a place where cats, dogs or other household pets are kept for the purpose of raising, breeding, boarding, training or selling them."

(2) by adding thereto the following, as subsection 20 (10):

"(10) A kennel, subject to the following restriction: any buildings, structures, enclosures or yards used in connection with a kennel shall not be located closer than 152m (500 ft) to a residential unit on an abutting or adjacent property; or,

where there is no dwelling unit on an adjacent or abutting lot, a kennel shall be located at least 152m (500 ft) away from the abutting or adjacent property line."
