WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton desires to undertake the development of Chinguacousy Park as set out in Schedule "A" attached hereto.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

- 1. That the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton shall undertake the development of Chinguacousy Park as as set out in Schedule "A" attached hereto at a total estimated cost of \$912,000.00.
- 2. That the Mayor and the Treasurer are hereby authorized in the name of and on behalf of the Corporation to borrow from time to time by way of promissory note from the Royal Bank of Canada, 1 Main Street North, Brampton, a sum or sums not exceeding in the aggregate \$912,000.00 for the aforementioned purpose and to give on behalf of the Corporation to the Royal Bank of Canada a promissory note or notes sealed with the Corporate Seal and signed by the Mayor and the Treasurer for the money so borrowed with interest which may be paid in advance or otherwise.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 22nd day of October 1984.

SCHEDULE "A" TO BY-LAW 256-84

- 1. Construction of a new (approximately 3000 square feet) park building in a centralized area (horeshoe pitch area) including washrooms, dressing rooms, snack bar, ticket booth/office and mechanical room;
- 2. Improvements to part drainage and erosion control;
- 3. Expansion and improvements to parking lots and roadways;
- 4. Development of picnic areas including picnic shelters;
- 5. Landscaping of park including tree and shrub planting, planters and flower beds;
- 6. Walkways, lighting for walkways, attraction and security and improvements or replacement of bridges;
- 7. General park improvements including main playground relocation and development of tot lots, sports bleachers, house improvements and usage, drinking fountains, tennis bubble, storage building, signage and other minor general park improvements.
