NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:


- 1) That Schedule "A" to By-law Number 25-77 be amended by the addition thereto of the following under the appropriate columns thereof:

<u>Column 1</u> <u>Intersection</u>	<u>Column 2</u> <u>Facing Traffic</u>
Edenborough Drive and Easton Place/Ellendale Cres.	Northbound on Edenborough Drive.
Edenborough Drive and Easton Place/Ellendale Cres.	Southbound on Edenborough Drive.
Edenborough Drive and Easton Place/Ellendale Cres.	Eastbound on Easton Place.
Edenborough Drive and Easton Place/Ellendale Cres.	Westbound on Ellendale Crescent.
Edenborough Drive and Ellendale Crescent/Essex Place	Northbound on Edenborough Drive.
Edenborough Drive and Ellendale Crescent/Essex Place	Southbound on Edenborough Drive.
Edenborough Drive and Ellendale Crescent/Essex Place	Eastbound on Essex Place.
Edenborough Drive and Ellendale Crescent/Essex Place	Westbound on Ellendale Crescent.
Archdekin Drive and Madoc Drive (easterly intersection)	Northbound on Archdekin Drive.
Archdekin Drive and Madoc Drive (easterly intersection)	Southbound on Archdekin Drive.
Archdekin Drive and Madoc Drive (easterly intersection)	Eastbound on Madoc Drive.

Edenborough Drive and Ellendale Crescent/Essex Place	Southbound on Edenborough Drive.
Edenborough Drive and Ellendale Crescent/Essex Place	Eastbound on Essex Place.
