THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

BY-LAW

Number 257-81

To amend By-law 5500, as amended,
of the former Town of Mississauga,
now in the City of Brampton.

The Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton hereby
ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law 5500, as amended, is hereby further amended:

(1) by adding to section 2 (DEFINITIONS) the following,
as subsection 20a:

"(20a) KENNEL shall mean a place where cats, dogs or
other household pets are kept for the purpose
of raising, breeding, boarding, training or
selling them."

(2) by adding to subsection (d) of section 23 the
following, as paragraph (IV):

"(IV) a kennel."


(3) by adding to section 24 the following as subsection
(7):

"Any buildings, structures, enclosures or yards used
in connection with a kennel shall not be located
closer than 152m (500 ft) to a residential unit on an
abutting or adjacent property; or,

where there is no dwelling on an adjacent or abutting
lot, a kennel shall be located at least 152m (500 ft)
away from the abutting or adjacent property line."
