To amend By-law 5500, as amended, of the former Town of Mississauga, now in the City of Brampton.

The Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton hereby ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law 5500, as amended, is hereby further amended:

- (1) by adding to section 2 (DEFINITIONS) the following, as subsection 20a:
 - "(20a) <u>KENNEL</u> shall mean a place where cats, dogs or other household pets are kept for the purpose of raising, breeding, boarding, training or selling them."

- (2) by adding to subsection (d) of section 23 the following, as paragraph (IV): "(IV) a kennel."
- (3) by adding to section 24 the following as subsection(7):

"Any buildings, structures, enclosures or yards used in connection with a kennel shall not be located closer than 152m (500 ft) to a residential unit on an abutting or adjacent property; or,

where there is no dwelling on an adjacent or abutting lot, a kennel shall be located at least 152m (500 ft) away from the abutting or adjacent property line."
