To amend By-law 193-83 (for the regulation of traffic)

WHEREAS the council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton deems it expedient and necessary to amend By-law 193-83, being a by-law for the regulation of traffic;


NOW THEREFORE the council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton hereby ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law 193-83, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding to Schedule I thereof the following items, under the appropriate columns thereof:
