 $\,$ THE COUNCIL of the Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law 15-91 is hereby amended as follows:

M

(1) Section 1 is amended by adding the following to the definition section:

"market" means that area, whether enclosed by a building or not, in which individual stalls are rented to vendors other than those who own the premises, for the purpose of individually exposing new or used goods and wares for sale and includes the type of establishment popularly referred to as a "flea market".

"stall" means a table, booth, counter or other similar sales facility, whether within or outside of a building and whether the table, booth, counter or other similar sales facility is or is not readily identifiable as a separate selling unit, and whether or not the table, booth, counter or other similar has any degree of permanence, which is, in fact, being used by an individual vendor within the market.

- 2. Section 2, subsection (27) is amended by deleting the letter "u'"in the word "everu" and adding the letter "y".
- In Section 2, after subsection (28) the following is added as subsection (29):
 - "(29) every person who maintains and operates a stall in a market".
- 4. In Section 40 the sum of "\$2,000.00" is deleted and the sum of "\$5,000.00" is added.
- 5. In Section 44, subsection (1) By-law "63-82" is added after By-law "311-82".

- 6. Schedule 6 of By-law 15-91 is hereby amended as follows:
 - (1) In Section 12 the words "forty-eight (48)" are deleted and the words "seventy-two (72)" is added.
 - (2) In Section 14, subsection (3) the words "forty-eight (48)" are deleted and the words "seventy-two (72)" are added.
- 7. Schedule 7 is hereby amended by deleting the words "forty-eight (48)" in Section 5 and adding the words "seventy-two (72)".
- 8. Schedule 8 is hereby amended by deleting the words "two (2) days" and adding the words "seventy-two (72) hours".
- 9. Schedule 20 is hereby amended by deleting the words "forty-eight (48)" in Section 2, subsection (4) and adding the words "seventy-two (72)".
- 10. Schedule 21 is hereby amended by adding subsection (6) after subsection (5) as follows:
 - "(6) provide to the City a current Copy of Health Inspection each year".
- 11. Schedule 24, section 5, subsection (3) is hereby amended as follows:
 - (1) the words "or 80% on second testing" is deleted;
 - (2) the number "30" is deleted and replaced by the number "90"; and
 - (3) by adding at the end of subsection (3) these words "Anybody found attempting to cheat on their test will not be allowed to rewrite the test for a period of three (3) years.
- 12. The attached Schedule shall be added as Schedule #29.
- 13. The Fee Schedule has been deleted and replaced by the attached Fee Schedule.

SCHEDULE NO. 29 TO BY-LAW NO. 15-91

Relating to persons maintaining and operating markets

- 1. Every owner of a market shall maintain in a book to be known as a register:
 - (1) a comprehensive record of vendors, names, addresses, phone numbers, driver's licence number, vehicle licence number, make of vehicle;
 - (2) make all entries at the time of rental or immediately thereafter;
 - (3) not knowingly make any false entries in the register;
 - (4) preserve all records for at least one (1) year; and
 - (5) keep the register available for inspection at any reasonable time when requested by an officer.
- 2. All licences issued in accordance with the provisions of this by-law shall be kept on display at the place of business for which they are issued.
