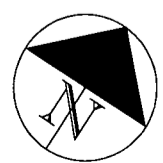


**LEGEND**

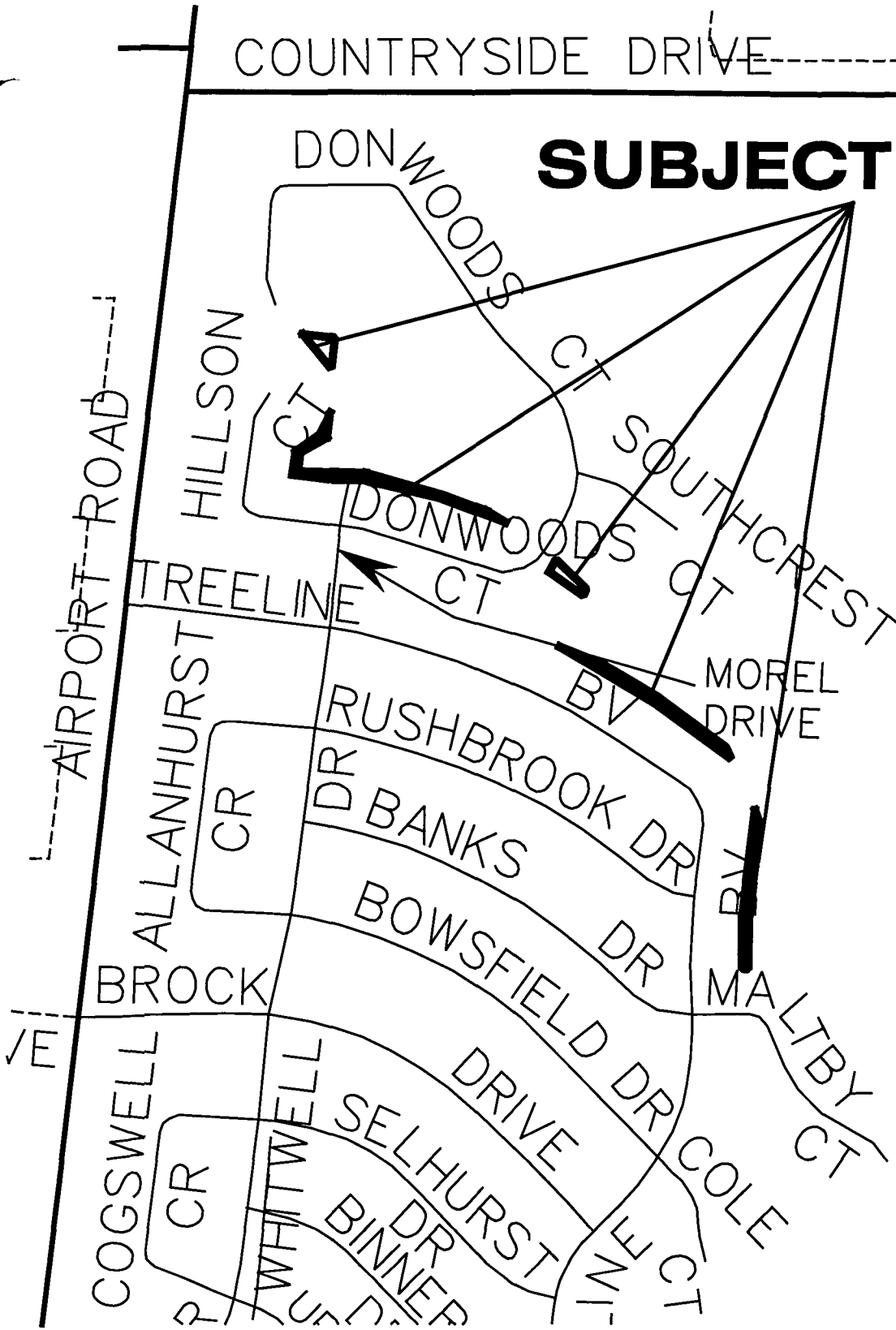

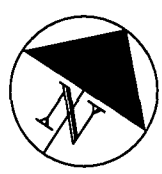


