1. By-law 200-82, as amended, is hereby further amended:

- (1) by deleting therefrom, section 6.14(a), and replacing therefor the following:
 - "6.14(a) an angled parking space shall be a rectangular area measuring not less than 2.70 metres in width, and 5.4 metres in length."
- (2) by deleting therefrom, section 6.15(d), and replacing therefor the following:
 - "6.15(d) Aisles leading to parking spaces and providing unobstructed access from each parking space to a driveway shall be established on the following basis:
