BY-LAW

Number 260-2008

To authorize the expropriation of certain lands for the purpose of Queen Street East Improvements


WHEREAS Section 5 (3) and 6 (1) of the Municipal Act 2001 require the Council of the Corporation to pass a by-law for acquiring or expropriating any land required for the purposes of the corporation;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the The Corporation of the City of Brampton has determined that it is necessary and in the interest of The Corporation of Brampton to acquire the lands herein described for road widening purposes and AcceleRide Improvements;

NOW THEREFORE The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. In this by-law, "AcceleRide Improvements" means a system of high occupancy lanes, bus only queue jump lanes and bus bays to provide for transit priority along Queen Street East.
2. The Corporation of the City of Brampton, as expropriating authority, is hereby authorized to make an application for approval to expropriate those property interests required in connection with the widening of Queen Street East between Highway 410 and Centre Street including AcceleRide Improvements as described in Schedule A to this report.
3. The City Clerk is hereby authorized to execute, on behalf of The Corporation of the City of Brampton as expropriating authority, all notices, applications, advertisements and other documents required by the Expropriations Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.E.26 as amended, in a form approved by the City Solicitor, in order to effect the expropriation of the said property rights.


