
BY-LAW NUMBER 261-75

Brampton ENACTS as follows:

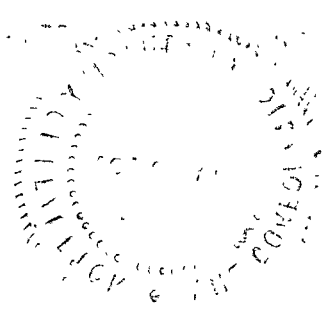
1. That the lands described in Schedule "A"
