part of public highways


WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to establish certain lands as part of the public highway system.

1. The lands acquired by the City of Brampton and described in Schedule A to this by-law are hereby established as parts of the public highways known as Provincial Place and North Park Drive.


READ A FIRST, SECOND, and THIRD TIME, and PASSED in open Council this **16th day of December, 1996.**
