To amend By-law 56-83 (part of Lot 15, Concession 9, N.D., in the geographic Township of Toronto Gore)

The council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

- 1. By-law 56-83, as amended, is hereby further amended:
 - (1) by changing, on Sheet 9 of Schedule A thereto, the zoning designation of the lands shown outlined on Schedule A to this by-law from RESIDENTIAL ESTATE HOLDING (REH) and FLOODPLAIN (F) to RESIDENTIAL ESTATE TWO (RE2), RESIDENTIAL ESTATE TWO-SECTION 582 (RE2-SECTION 582) and FLOODPLAIN (F), such lands being part of Lot 15, Concession 9, Northern Division, in the geographic Township of Toronto Gore.
 - (2) by adding thereto the following section:
 - "582 The lands designated RE2-SECTION 582 on Sheet 9 of Schedule A to this by-law:
 - 582.1 shall only be used for the purposes permitted by section 11.2.1
 - 582.2 shall be subject to the following requirements and restrictions:
 - (a) the minimum lot width shall be 25.0 metres
 - 582.3 shall also be subject to the requirements and restrictions relating to the RE2 zone, and all the general provisions of this by-law, which are not in conflict with those set out in section 582.2."


