## THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

**BY-LAW** 

262-2002 Number \_\_\_\_

To prevent the application of part lot control to part of Registered Plans 43M-1472, 43M-1504, and 43M-1510,

WHEREAS subsection 50(5) of the <u>Planning Act</u>, R.S.O. 1990 c.P.13, has imposed part lot control on all lands within registered plans within the City;

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to subsection 50(7) of the <u>Planning Act</u>, the Council of a municipality may by by-law provide that part lot control does not apply to lands within such registered plans or parts thereof as are designated in the by-law;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton hereby ENACTS as follows:

Subsection 5 of section 50 of the <u>Planning Act</u>, does not apply to the following lands:

City of Brampton, Regional Municipality of Peel, being composed of:

The whole of Lots 23, 25, and 26, on Registered Plan 43M-1472

The whole of Lots 156 - 159 inclusive, 164, 165, 168, 182, 184, 185, and blocks 465 - 471 inclusive and 474, on Registered Plan 43M-1504

The whole of block 684, on Registered Plan 43M-1510

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 16<sup>th</sup> day of September 2002.
