# **BY-LAW**

Number 263-2003	3
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To amend By-law 151-88, as amended

The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

- 1. By-law 151-88, as amended, is hereby further amended:
  - designation of the lands shown outlined on Schedule A to this by-law from AGRICULTURAL (A) and OPEN SPACE to RESIDENTIAL SINGLE FAMILY C SECTION 1179 (R1C SECTION 1179), RESIDENTIAL SINGLE FAMILY D SECTION 1180 (R1D SECTION 1180), RESIDENTIAL TWO FAMILY C SECTION 1181 (R2C SECTION 1181), RESIDENTIAL STREET TOWNHOUSE B SECTION 1182 (R3B SECTION 1182), INSTITUTIONAL ONE SECTION 1224 (I1 SECTION 1224), INSTITUTIONAL ONE SECTION 1225 (I1 SECTION 1225) and OPEN SPACE (OS).
  - (2) by adding thereto, the following sections:
    - "1224 The lands designated I1 SECTION 1224 on Sheet 23 of Schedule A to this by-law:
    - shall only be used for the purposes permitted by section 1224.1 (1) or the purposes permitted by section 1224.1(2), but not both sections or not any combination of both sections:

## either:

- (1) a) a public or private school;
  - b) a day nursery;
  - c) a park, playground or recreation facility operated by a public authority; and,
  - d) purposes accessory to the other permitted purposes.

- (2) a) those purposes permitted in a R1D SECTION 1180 zone; and,
  - b) a park, playground or recreation facility operated by a public authority.
- shall be subject to the following requirements and restrictions:
  - (1) for those purposes permitted in a R1D SECTION 1180 zone, the requirements and restrictions as set out in a R1D SECTION 1180 zone.
- shall also be subject to the requirements and restrictions relating to the I1 zone and all the general provisions of this by-law which are not in conflict with the ones set out in section 1224.2
- The lands designated II- SECTION 1225 on Sheet 23 of Schedule A to this by-law:
- shall only be used for the purposes permitted by section 1225.1 (1) or the purposes permitted by section 1225.1 (2), but not both sections or not any combination of both sections:

either:

- (1) a) a public or private school;
  - b) a day nursery;
  - c) a park, playground or recreation facility operated by public authority; and,
  - d) purposes accessory to the other permitted purposes

or:

- (2) a) those purposes permitted in a R2C SECTION 1181 zones; and,
  - b) a park, playground or recreation facility operated by a public authority.
- shall be subject to the following requirements and restrictions:
  - (1) for those purposes permitted in a R2C SECTION 1181 zone, the requirements and restrictions as set out in a R2C SECTION 1181 zone.
- shall also be subject to the requirements and restrictions relating to the I1 zone and all the general provisions of this by-law which are not in conflict with the ones set out in section 1225.2"

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in OPEN COUNCIL, this 15th day of 2003.


