

## THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

## **BY-LAW**

Number 263-2006

To authorize the sale of land to Peel District School Board, being Part of Lot 13, Concession 6, EHS, City of Brampton designated as part 1, Plan 43R-30561

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient and in the interest of The Corporation of the City of Brampton that the land described as part of Lot 13, Concession 12, EHS, City of Brampton designated as part 1, Plan 43R-30561 (the "Land"), be sold to Peel District School Board.

AND WHEREAS the Land is to be used for joint parking and access in connection with the proposed shared-use campus for the Springdale East Secondary School – Torbram-Sandalwood Park development;

AND WHEREAS the procedures required by section 268 of the *Municipal Act, 2001* have been carried out;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton has heard in person or by counsel, solicitor or agent, all persons claiming that their land will be prejudicially affected by this by-law and who applied to be heard;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS**:

- 1. That the City-owned lands described as Part 1 on Registered Plan 43R-30561, City of Brampton, (the "Land") are hereby declared to be surplus.
- 2. That the Land be conveyed to Peel District School Board on terms and conditions satisfactory to the Commissioner of Community Services and in a form of agreement satisfactory to the City Solicitor, and the Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute all documents and instruments as may be necessary to effect the conveyance of the Land.

**READ** a **FIRST**, **SECOND** and **THIRD TIME** and **PASSED** in Open Council this 2nd day of August, 2006.
