# BY-LAW

Number 264-78

Being a By-law to establish a Community Recreation Centre on Knightsbridge Road.

WHEREAS Section 2 (1) of The Community Recreation Centres Act, 1974, provides that the Council of a municipality may, by By-law, provide for the establishment, maintenance and operation of a Community Recreation Centre in accordance with the said Act;


AND WHEREAS The Corporation of the City of Brampton is desirous of establishing a Community Recreation Centre on the land more particularly described in Schedule "A" attached hereto.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. That a Community Recreation Centre, defined as a Community Hall, be established, maintained and operated by The Corporation of the City of Brampton pursuant to the provisions of The Community Recreation Centres Act, 1974 on the land more particularly described in Schedule 'A' attached hereto.
2. That this Centre be known as the "KNIGHTSBRIDGE COMMUNITY AND SENIOR CITIZENS CENTRE."
3. That the Mayor and the Clerk be and they are hereby authorized to execute all documents necessary to give effect thereto.

SCHEDULE 'A'

LEGAL DESCRIPTION OF THE LANDS

ALL AND SINGULAR that certain parcel or tract of land and premises situate, lying and being in the City of Brampton in the Regional Municipality of Peel (formerly in the Township of Chinguacousy in the County of Peel) and being composed of that Part of Lot 5, Concession 4, East of Hurontario Street, more particularly designated as Part 1 on a Plan of Survey deposited in the Registry Office for the Registry Division of Peel (No. 43) as Plan 43R-5859.
