BY-LAW

Number 265-77

A By-law to amend By-law Number 1827, as amended, of the former Town of Brampton now in the City of Brampton.

The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS that By-law Number 1827, as amended, of the former Town of Brampton is hereby further amended as follows:

1. Clause 7.1(a) which reads as follows:

"Any use permitted in the Residential Zone, Neighbourhood Commercial Zone, subject to the restrictions and regulations to such zone but not including single or two family dwellings"


be deleted and be replaced with the following:


"Any use permitted in the Residential Zone and Neighbourhood Commercial Zone, subject to the restrictions and regulations to such zone, but not including single, two family dwellings, semi-detached including duplex and double duplex dwellings and three family dwellings."

2. Clause (o) of Section 7.1 be deleted.
3. Clause 8.1(a) be deleted and the following substituted:
"Any use permitted in sub-sections (e), (k), (m) and (n) of Section 7.1."

4. The By-law shall take effect on the date of enactment by Council subject to Ontario Municipal Board approval.
