A By-law to authorize a capital expenditure in the amount of \$660,000.00 for the reconstruction of certain streets.


WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton desires to undertake the reconstruction of certain streets as set out in Schedule "A" attached hereto and forming part of the By-law;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. That the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton shall undertake the reconstruction of certain streets as set out in Schedule "A" attached hereto and forming part of this By-law at a total estimated cost of \$660,000.00.
2. That the Mayor and the Treasurer are hereby authorized in the name of and on behalf of the Corporation to borrow from time to time by way of promissory note from the Royal Bank of Canada, 1 Main Street North, Brampton, a sum or sums not exceeding in the aggregate \$660,000.00 for the aforementioned purpose and to give on behalf of the Corporation to the Royal Bank of Canada a promissory note or notes sealed with the Corporate Seal and signed by the Mayor and the Treasurer for the money so borrowed with interest which may be paid in advance or otherwise.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 6th day of November, 1978.

SCHEDULE "A" to BY-LAW 265-78

Reconstruction of ROADS including storm sewers and outlet excavation, granular base, concrete curb and gutter, asphalt paving, boulevards and related works on:

1. ARGYLE CRESCENT from Avondale Boulevard to Avondale Boulevard
2. ASCOT AVENUE from Addington Crescent (south leg) to Ascot Court
3. ASCOT COURT from Ascot Avenue to the end of the court
4. ALSTON COURT from Cornwall Road to Cornwall Road
5. MCCAUL STREET from Centre Street to Sophia Street
6. ROYCE AVENUE from McMurphy Avenue to Haggart Avenue.
