



THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

BY-LAW

Number 267-2004

To prevent the application of part lot control to part of
Registered Plan 43M - 1601

WHEREAS subsection 50(5) of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. c. P.13, as amended, has imposed part lot control on all lands within registered plans within the City;

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to subsection 50(7) of the *Planning Act*, the Council of a municipality may, by by-law, provide that subsection 50(5) of the *Planning Act* does not apply to land within such registered plan or plans of subdivision or parts thereof, as are designated in the by-law;

AND WHEREAS, the application for an exemption from part lot control, pursuant to subsection 50(7) of the *Planning Act*, on the lands described below, **for the purpose of creating maintenance easements**, is to the satisfaction of the City of Brampton;

NOW THEREFORE, The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. THAT subsection 50(5) of the *Planning Act* does not apply to the following lands:


City of Brampton, Regional Municipality of Peel, being composed of:


The whole of lots 2 – 4 inclusive, 6 – 8 inclusive, 10 – 12 inclusive, 14, 221, 222, 224, 225, 227, 232 – 234 inclusive, 237, 239 – 241 inclusive, 245, 248 – 250 inclusive, 272, 276, and 301 on Registered Plan 43M-1601;

2. THAT, pursuant to subsection 50(7.3) of the *Planning Act*, this by-law shall expire on July 27th, 2005.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 13th day of September 2004.
