> A by-law to provide for reduced hours of voting in institutions and retirement homes for the 2006 City of Brampton Municipal Election

WHEREAS Section 46(3) of the Municipal Elections Act, 1996 provides that the council of a municipality may pass a by-law with respect to reduced voting hours in voting places in retirement homes or those institutions as defined in Section 45(7) of the said Act, where the voting place is only for the use of the residents;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

That voting shall be held at the locations and times as noted below, with respect to the Municipal Election to be held November 13, 2006:
