


THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON





To authorize the permanent closure of part of the public highway known as Auction Lane and surplus declaration of land.

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient and in the interest of the Corporation of the City of Brampton that the part of Auction Lane described in Schedule A to this by-law ("Closed Road Part") be permanently closed;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient and in the interest of the Corporation of the City of Brampton that the Closed Road Part, and that Part of Lot 5, Conc. 7 N.D., Brampton, described in Schedule B ("Loop Road Lands'), be declared surplus;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to By-laws 393-2002 and 273-2005 notice of the intention to pass this by-law has been published in the Brampton Guardian newspaper a minimum of five and not more than twenty-one days prior to the Council meeting at which this by-law was considered:

AND WHEREAS the Council for the said Corporation has heard in person or by counsel, solicitor or agent, all persons claiming that their land will be prejudicially affected by this by-law and who applied to be heard;

NOW THEREFORE The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

- 1. The part of the public highway known as Auction Lane and described in Schedule A to this by-law, the Closed Road Part, is hereby permanently closed.
- 2. Subject to the registration of the by-law closing the Closed Road Part, as described in Schedule A, the Closed Road Part and the Loop Road lands described in Schedule B are declared surplus.
- 3. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute all documents and instruments approved by the City Solicitor as may be necessary to give effect to this by-law.
